❖ **What is Plan for the Future Summer Camp 2008?**

Plan for the Future Summer Camp 2008 is a one-week, half-day summer experience for middle-schools students. They will have the opportunity to explore two appealing career areas and solve real-work challenges! Summer Camp classes, set in an exploratory classroom or lab, are designed to challenge students and expose them to several facets of a career. Students can elect to attend one or both camps. Transportation to and from the camp is the responsibility of participants.

- Current 5th, 6th, or 7th grader
- Registration fee is \$150 (tuition assistance available, if eligible)
